MODULE 1 | LEADERSHIP



What makes me?

Module 1 invites students to reflect on identity and diversity with respect to leadership development and global citizenship. The art-making begins with projects that encourage students to use familiar materials in new ways, exploring the basic geometry of lines, angles, and 2D shapes throughout the artistic process.

MODULE 2 | CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

What's my role in my community?

Module 2 introduces civic engagement through design thinking and engineering principles, toward local community action. The projects integrate traditional and contemporary media in sequential pathways toward artistic mastery. Students are encouraged to think as artists, engineers, and mathematicians as they think critically and develop creative solutions for their communities.

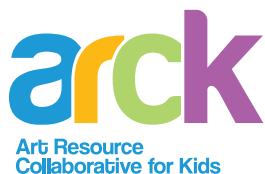


MODULE 3 | SOCIAL JUSTICE

Module 3 introduces social justice issues on a global scale and empowers students as agents for change. Projects include a variety of 3D media, and prompt students to create artwork that engages their communities in dialog about social justice. This module connects to earth science, providing students with tools to recognize the ways in which their art interacts with the earth, society, and public space.
